Hidden treasures



Pitch perfect

Are you a nature-loving traveller wanting to explore the outskirts of Ibiza?

In the village of Sant Joan, the two most emblematic buildings are the small Casa Consistorial, the home of the town council and the church. The community is made up of four parishes: Sant Joan, Sant Miquel, Sant Vicent and Sant Llorenç. They are small villages in which local neighbours live side by side with people who have arrived from all over the world wanting to seek peace and quiet in the most rural depths of Ibiza.

It is the area of the island with the lowest number of inhabitants and it stands out because it offers the wildest natural landscapes, with

spectacular cliffs that have been declared as a Natural Area of Special Interest, since both flora and fauna of great value live side by side in its ecosystems. It has always been an area famed for its great number of springs, for the quality of its honey and for the fertility of its land, which is tinted with an intense rust red colour.

Sites of special interest to tourists



Sant Miquel de Balansat: You will be able to find all kinds of attractions all the way along its main street throughout all seasons of the year. A must-see attraction is the church built on a hill. The port of Sant Miquel de Balansat is one of the most important tourist spots enclosed in Sant Joan's traditional architecture, with hotels, restaurants in where you'll be able to sample the fresh fish of the island or visit shops and leisure facilities.

Taste of paradise

Aqua Blancas

Appreciate the beautiful scenery of Sant Carles, Ibiza. The rugged cliffs and clear shallow waters are the perfect pick for those who love to swim. Due to the small size of the beach, expect to see a few nudists.

Benirras

Benirras is located in Sant Joan (one of Ibiza's most adored

towns). The bay is calm and collective, surrounded by hills, recommended for tourists who enjo snorkelling.

Cala Bassa

Cala Bassa offers breathtaking views of the infamous promontory of Cap Nono and San Antonia. Stroll down the striking white sandy beach and along the shady pine forest offering you a sheltered break, away from the warmth rises of the sun.

Formentera

Looking for a Caribbean beach type holiday without the enormous price tag? Formentera offers the best of both worlds, it's only a 30 minutes boat journey from Ibiza Town to the small Formentera island. The beach scenery is simply to die for. Dip into the clear blue waters and enjoy the exotic cocktails.

Sightseeing

Hippy Market

Enjoy a shopping experience like no other at Ibiza's must see attraction. Las Dalias "Hippy" Market takes place every Saturday with thousands of people coming to visit it, particularly between 1st May and 31st October. At this market you will find a whole world of Adlib clothing, costume jewellery, sandalwood, exotic musical instruments, ethnic music CDs, jewellery, decorative fabrics, little figures, Hindu antiques, wrap-around pareus, books and much more. In the market area there is also a restaurant and some cafes where you will be able to taste freshly squeezed juices or Arab cakes. Or, why not take a trip to see the Las Salinas Salt Flats, which have been used for over 2000 years. Take a bottle of champagne and enjoy the spectacular sunset, setting over the pure sparkling layers of salt left at the bottom of the lakes.

Boat Charter

Relax, Refocus, Regenerate

Its crystal-clear waters and a spectacular coastline over 200km in length mean that Ibiza is a popular place to go diving. As such, there are a number of firms specialising both in diving courses carried out by professionals. There are also guided tours, which enable visitors to discover and learn about the sea life and discover the wonders under the deep clear waters. The seabeds in the National Park of Las Salinas with prairies of Posidonia are of great ecological

value and were given the status of World Heritage. If you are looking for a reviving diving experience we recommend the Don Pedro roll-on/roll-off boat. In the summer of 2007 the boat hit underwater rocks off the islet of 'Dado pequeno' near the Ibiza harbour. It ended up on the sea floor, up to 45 metres below the surface. It has since acquired a reputation as one of Europe's finest shipwrecks for divers.



Nicole Moudaber

If you want to discover the real Ibiza, keep on reading! DJ, Producer and label owner Nicole Moudabe uncovers the spiritual side to the Island and announces 2013 projects with the legendary Mr Carl Cox. Born in Ibadan in Nigeria, Nicole's inspiration came from the African drum beats and passion for music the locals carried. She later moved to London where she began a career in the clubbing industry as a promoter. She soon came to realise the gift she was given and began proceeding a new career as a music producer and DJ. Nicole has changed the sound of deep tech house and made it her own. One of Moudaber's biggest achievements to date is remixing Sian & Mladen Tomec's 'Front Pocket' on Octopus and her version of Carl Cox 'Chemistry' on Intec. The remix

scooped a prestigious IDMA award at Miami's Winter Music Conference, winning the title for 'Best Minimal/ Techno Track'. A few have described her as the Queen of deep house tech sound because not only does Nicole's music uplifts you but it also brings you back to life. With a brand new album out this year and with the new launch of Mood Records owned by Nicole, she is fiercely taking over the world.

Nicole calls Ibiza her second home and during our interview we find out what made her decide to purchase a house on the Island. We were surprised by what she had to say and thanks to Moudaber our perception of Ibiza has been altered slightly. Will she be back to Space for the fifth season? Well, you just have to flip over to the next page and find out.



Inside Ibiza welcomes

Nicole Moudabe

You started your career in the club industry as a promoter in London, booking DJs. What inspired you to become a DJ yourself?

The music, I love music and I'm still passionate about it, now more than ever. It's a constant dialogue between the world and myself.

Ibiza is your second home, so you must know the island inside out. What would be the must see or do things for first time travellers? What would you recommend first time travellers must see and do?

You must see Ibiza from the sea. The island is very energetic; Es Vedra is the point where everyone should experience. The first time I saw it was from a house on a cliff, overlooking straight onto the magic rock. The next visit was on my boat, approaching Es Vedra for the first time, that was such a majestic experience to me. What was it like? I will never forget it, dark water, silence and lots of energies flowing. You're compelled to be humble by that rock.

So far the DJs line up has not been officially announced, nonetheless, where can you see yourself?

You can see me in Space Ibiza and a beach party I will be DJing at.

What can we expect from your new album?

It's a mixture of deep, tech and techno sound. I have tested every track so far with the crowd and a few DJs have it already, it's been damaging floors around the world. So far the tracks have received early support from Carl Cox, Richie Hawtin and Adam Beyer. I just finished putting the finishing touches on my collaboration with Adam Beyer, which will also be included on the album.

Recently, DJs have changed the music they produced in order to keep up with current trends, have you changed your style of music or are you sticking to techno and house?

My style is what I understand and know well, so I will stick to it. Weather it's house, techno, deep house or tech house only because I feel it. I can never do an electro house, trance, dubstep etc...it doesn't mean much to me I'm afraid.

You recently launched your new record label 'Mood Records' at Pacha NYC. What kind of artists are you

looking for? Is it a variety of music styles or are you mainly concentrating on finding techno and house talent?

Mood Records is a mixture of my music, collaborations with artists, new comers too. I will invite friends and people I admire to work with me. If I play it in a club, festival or at home then I will release it.

Carl Cox has played a huge part in the growth of your career. Can you tell us how you met and how the working relationship blossomed?

He supported my music on his radio shows at first, and then he invited me to open for him in London. It was an intimate gig for 500 people for the launch of his DVD. A few months later I was invited to play at Space in Ibiza for the summer and have been a regular guest since. We developed an amazing friendship along the way, we play together internationally as well, share music, talk about everything and nothing too. He's awesome.

Will you be joining Carl Cox's Revolution night at Space this year?

Yeah, you coming? Of course, I'll be dancing the night away with your new singles!

What made you decide to buy a house in Ibiza and why do you love the Island so much?

It reminded me about Lebanon a bit and when I looked at the guide books in Ibiza and I was surprised to find out it was discovered by The Phoenicians, and the Lebanese were the Phoenicians. I instantly felt the connection the Mediterranean feel it's unmistakable. Ibiza is a very spiritual island, peaceful and yet it can bite you as well - to me, Ibiza is a woman.

Thank you so much for taking part and we look forward to seeing you in Ibiza this year.







Inside Ibiza interviews DJs and Music Producers 'StarRockers'

How did you guys meet and decide to form StarRockers?

A mutual friend introduced us, and we sort of "clicked" straight away musically, starting to share ideas and making tracks together.

You have DJed all around the world, how would you describe the experience and atmosphere in Ibiza?

Ibiza always surprises us with something different, it's never the same. The atmosphere is electric, people go to Ibiza to party and really enjoy themselves. That's what counts.

One of my favourite tracks from your collaboration is "Feeling". You both said previously that the song is about a series of emotions and you have also included it in the Boudior Club playlist. Tell us a bit more about that?

Thank you very much. We're also very found of Feeling and we will be shortly releasing the full vocal version out on our label. The Boudoir Club playlist is something we have been working on for a while. The playlist is a collaboration of well known DJs working together to bring out an intimately sensual sound to Ibiza.

How would you describe your sound and production?

It's not an easy one because we have a lot of influences, and not just from the electronic music world. However the club scene is where we exist and belong, so a good way to describe our sound and production would be the combination of many different elements into a dance floor friendly format.

You recently launched StarRocker records and following the foot steps of many other DJs who have done the same. Why do you think DJs are starting to launch their own record companies and what kind of talent are you looking for to join the StarRocker empire?

Yes we have and are very excited about it. It's definitely something we have wanted to do for a long time and we're very much looking forward to grow our label. Many other DJs have done this before and it's really a good position to be in as it gives 'you' artistic freedom to release what you want, without too much commercial pressure. Another reason we have decided to do so is because we live in London, where talent is quite literally present at every street corner. Being in a position to help other artists to be known more, and help them get there is something we're very found of.

How is the Inside Ibiza Playlist different from the Boudoir Club mix you did our readers to download (free of charge)?

The Inside Ibiza playlist is a "main room" or "peak time" set, something we put together to take your breath away, make your feet move, your body shake and gradually taking you to an epic climax. The Boudoir Club Mix is not quite as "directed", but more of an invitation to let the mind imagine, wonder and to let go over a scenery of sensual grooves and sounds.

We just have to ask, when you are on the island where do you go? What are your favourite spots?

Ohhh, that's a though one! We like to take a boat out to Formentera, the beach is great. Ushuaia is a must see and for a quick bite we love Ibiza Rocks Restaurant in Playa de Bossa.

You will be our official DJs for the Inside Ibiza parties we are having around the world, what else can we expect to see from StarRockers this year?

Yes that's right, and we're delighted and looking forward to it a lot! For the year ahead, we have lots of projects and plans, so without saying too much, it's probably best to say that you can expect a lot from us this year.







Tourist Information

Weather in Ibiza

Although the summer season starts from April and winds down in October, the islands are beautiful in early spring when the almond blossom is out.

The warmest months are July and August with temperatures reaching as high as 40C between 14:00 – 16:00 o'clock. Autumn and Winter are generally quiet and cool but there are still many activities and attractions to see. Pacha Ibiza is usually open to the public during the weekend and resumes to seven nights a week in late May / June when the party season kicks off for another year.

Getting there

Airlines flying from UK airports include British Airways (0870 850 9850). Air Berlin (0871 5000737) Monarch (0871 9405040;_), Easyjet (0843 1045000), Thomas Cook (0871 2302406) Thomson (0871 2314787), Jet2 (0906 3020660) and Ryanair (0871 2460000). If you are looking for private flights, visit Ibiza Access. Flights are limited in winter and you may have to travel via Palma, Madrid or Barcelona.

Ibiza airport (971 809000) is 7.5 km (4.7 miles) south-west of Ibiza town. Usually the majority of flights are either very early or late in the evening. A taxi from the airport to Ibiza Town will cost approximately £10 - 12 depending on the area and traffic.

Getting around

<u>Ibiza Bus</u> (971 340383) goes from the airport to Ibiza town, Sant Antoni and Santa Eulalia, as well as all to towns and villages all around the island. The bus fair to the centre is 3.60€ and tickets must be purchased before boarding.

The <u>Discobus</u> service operates from June-September and runs all night between the various clubs.

Car Hire- Read the small print in the contract and make sure you are fully covered for driving on unmade roads as this may cause same damage to the vehicle, especially if you are planning to go for a drive in the North of Ibiza.

Local laws and etiquette

Before you travel, it's advisable to get a couple of photocopies of your European Health card and passport, in case you require any medical treatment during your stay.

Spanish law defines anyone under 18 to be a minor, subject to parental control or adult supervision. On entry at clubs, you may be asked for ID and if you are under 18 years of age, entry will be refused.

By Spanish law it is illegal to smoke in indoor public places i.e. bars, restaurants, airports, shopping centres. Smoking is also considered illegal outside hospitals, schools and children's play parks. Fines for breaking laws range from €30 to €600k and are being strictly enforced by the local authority. There are also strict controls on drinking and sexual activity in public places, including beaches, where regulations have increased significantly. Fines range from €30-€1,500.

Hotels have a legal duty to register the passport details of tourists when they check-in. A photocopy of your passport will be made and kept on file for safety measures. This is normal procedure across Ibiza Island and Spain and it's nothing to be concerned about.
